Instructions before filling Online Public Data Entry Form:

- 1. Click on **PUBLIC DATA ENTRY** in the Homepage of eregistration.uk.gov.in
- 2. Create a Sign In by simply filling the details required.
- 3. Select the DEED & SUB-DEED type.
- 4. Select village/location & Index and select the circle rate.
- 5. Tick the appropriate Rebate option (If Applicable).
- 6. Enter property details such as Khasra no., Khatoni no., Area, House/Flat no. (If Applicable), etc.
- 7. Enter <u>Residential Construction / Industrial Construction</u> details if property type is Building/Flat etc or if Applicable.
- 8. Enter the Transaction details such as Advance Security, Pagdi, Transaction Value, Mode of payment, Execution date and Deed writer Name.
- 9. Click on Calculate Stamp & Registration Duty button.
- 10. In <u>Total Pages</u> & <u>Total words in Deed</u> column fill the details according to the following example:
 - a. 5 Stamp pages + 1 PDE Page = 6 Pages X 2 = 12 Pages. (Count both sides of a single page)
 - b. Total words in the deed are minimum 1000 words and maximum are 9800 words.
- 11. Fill Stamp Details & Fees Details by clicking blue buttons on the bottom right hand side of the page.
- 12. Click on Save & Continue button.
- 13. PDE ID will be generated automatically. Now copy the PDE ID and click on Go To Login Page.
- 14. Again go to PUBLIC DATA ENTRY and Click on Already have PDE ID Login Here.
- 15. Now Login by Entering PDE ID and Password created earlier during Sign In.
- 16. Go to <u>ADD PARTY DETAILS</u> menu and fill First Party, Second Party and Witness details. And click on SAVE button.
- 17. After the Party details are filled, click on <u>Print Report</u> and take the print out of the same.
- 18. After the PDE report is printed, go to View PDE Status menu and click on SUBMIT TO SRO button.
- 19. ONLINE PUBLIC DATA ENTRY IS COMPLETE.

REGISTRATION FEES DETAILS:-

- 1. For transaction/market values greater than Rs. 12,50,000 Registration fees will be Rs. 25,000.
- 2. For transaction/market values less than Rs. 12,50,000 Registration fees will be 2% of the Transaction Value/Market Value (Whichever is Greater).

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED WITH DEED:-

- 1. Recent passport size photograph.
- 2. ID proof (Voter ID/ Aadhar/ DL/ Passport/ Bank Passbook/PAN Card etc.)
- 3. PAN Card/Form 60 is mandatory for transactions above Rs 500000.
- 4. Recent photograph of property to be transferred.
