2- The Government of Uttar Pradesh conveys its concurrence with the proposal of the Ministry of Company Affairs, Government of India and advise as under.

(i) The Government of Uttar Pradesh authorizes the Ministry of Company Affairs, Government of India to electronically generate the stamp paper through MCA 21 scheme on behalf of the State Government for the specific purpose of filing under the provisions of Company Act, 1956,

(ii) The Government of Uttar Pradesh notifies and authorizes the following bank branches to receive payments on account of stamp duty under MCA 21 - the e-governance Project of the Ministry of Company Affairs and remit the same directly to the account of the State Government with Central Accounts Section, Reserve bank of India, Nagpur in accordance with the approved payment and accounting procedure.
